

ORDINANCE NO. 1186

AN ORDINANCE OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL AMENDING SECTION 3-1-250 OF THE DRAPER CITY MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE DRAPER CITY YOUTH COUNCIL ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, Draper City established the Draper Youth Council Advisory Board to assist and advise the Draper City Youth Council; and

WHEREAS, the current membership language in Section 3-1-250(B) defines the number of advisory members and includes a City staff member as an advisor; and

WHEREAS, the recently created a part-time Youth Council staff position and it is no longer necessary to appoint a staff member to the advisory board.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 3-1-250 of the Draper City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, part, or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance, and all sections, parts, and provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication or posting, or 30 days after final passage, whichever is closer to the date of final passage.



EXHIBIT A

COMPLETE PROPOSED TEXT AMENDMENT

Section 3-1-250 Draper City Youth Council Advisory Board.

(a) Creation. There is hereby created the Draper City Youth Council Advisory Board to assist the Draper City Youth Council and to advise said Council in creation of work projects, service opportunities, disbursement of scholarship monies, selection of activities and programs for the Youth Council and utilization of the City's Youth in the community for the benefit of Draper City residents.

(b) Members.

(1) Number. The advisory board shall be comprised of five but no less than three members who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Draper City Council. ~~Among the members will be one City staff member.~~ To the extent available in the community, additional members should have experience or specialized knowledge dealing with education, business and economic development, or political activity sufficient to contribute in a coordinating and advisory capacity to the Youth Council regarding its events and activities.

(2) Term. Members shall be appointed to terms of two years. In order to provide for proper staggering of terms so that all appointments do not expire at the same time and to provide appropriate opportunities for involvement by a variety of interested persons, two initial membership positions shall be for a term of two years, and three initial membership position shall be for a term of one year.

(3) Removal. The Mayor, with the consent of City Council, may remove members who are not participating or attending Youth Council Advisory Board meetings and activities.

(c) Organization and Procedure.

(1) Senior Advisor. The Youth Council Advisory Board ~~Mayor, with the advice and consent of the City Council,~~ shall appoint an Advisor to oversee the proceedings and activities of the Board.

(2) Board Organization. The Board shall consist of the Senior Advisor, Assistant Advisor, Treasurer and Historian.

(3) Rules. The Board may propose reasonable bylaws, rules and regulations in accordance with this section for governing the conduct of its meetings.

(4) **Meetings.** The Board shall hold meetings monthly or as needed at such times as it shall determine and as properly called with notice of such meetings given to each Board member and as required by law. The Youth Council shall meet weekly from September to May, with periodic meetings during the summer as needed.

(d) **Duties.** It shall be the duty of the Board to act in a volunteer capacity as advisors to the Draper City Youth Council and as liaisons between the Youth Council and the Draper City community at large. The Advisory Board shall help and assist the Youth Council in preparing its members for public or government service, providing service opportunities to the community through volunteer projects, educating Draper City youth on issues of importance in Draper City and fostering positive feelings of self-worth and esteem in members of the Youth Council and Draper City youth in general, and providing special interest projects for the Youth Council and Draper City youth.
