

**ORDINANCE NO. 1369**

**AN ORDINANCE OF DRAPER CITY ADOPTING THE UTAH WILDLAND URBAN INTERFACE CODE AND DESIGNATING WILDLAND URBAN INTERFACE AREAS OF DRAPER CITY**

**WHEREAS**, Title 7 Chapter 10 of the Draper City Municipal Code has been established to provide regulations concerning fire protection for general developments within the City Boundaries; and

**WHEREAS**, Draper City has developed and adopted the Draper City Community Wildfire Protection Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Draper City Council has determined that certain geographical areas within the corporate boundaries of Draper City shall be subject to the Utah Wildland Urban Interface Code as amended and shown in Exhibit "B"; and

**WHEREAS**, the Draper City Council desires to amend Section 7-10-020 of the Draper City Municipal Code as shown in Exhibit "A" and adopt an official map as shown in Exhibit "B" designating areas subject to the Utah Wildland Urban Interface Code as amended.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Findings.** The Draper City Council has made the following findings:

- 1) The Draper City Council recognizes the importance of enhancing its ability to mitigate the potentially devastating impacts of wildfire.
- 2) The Draper City Council recognizes the importance of reducing the human suffering, property damage, interruption of public services and economic losses caused by wildfire.
- 3) The Draper City Council recognizes that wildfire poses a particular, significant, and ongoing threat to the City of Draper.
- 4) This Ordinance promotes the health, safety and general welfare of Draper City residents.


**Section 2.** Section 7-10-020 of the Draper City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as shown in Exhibit "A" and a map of the designated area shown as Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 3. Severability.** If any section, part or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance, and all sections, parts and provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication or posting, or 30 days after final passage, whichever is closer to the date of final passage.

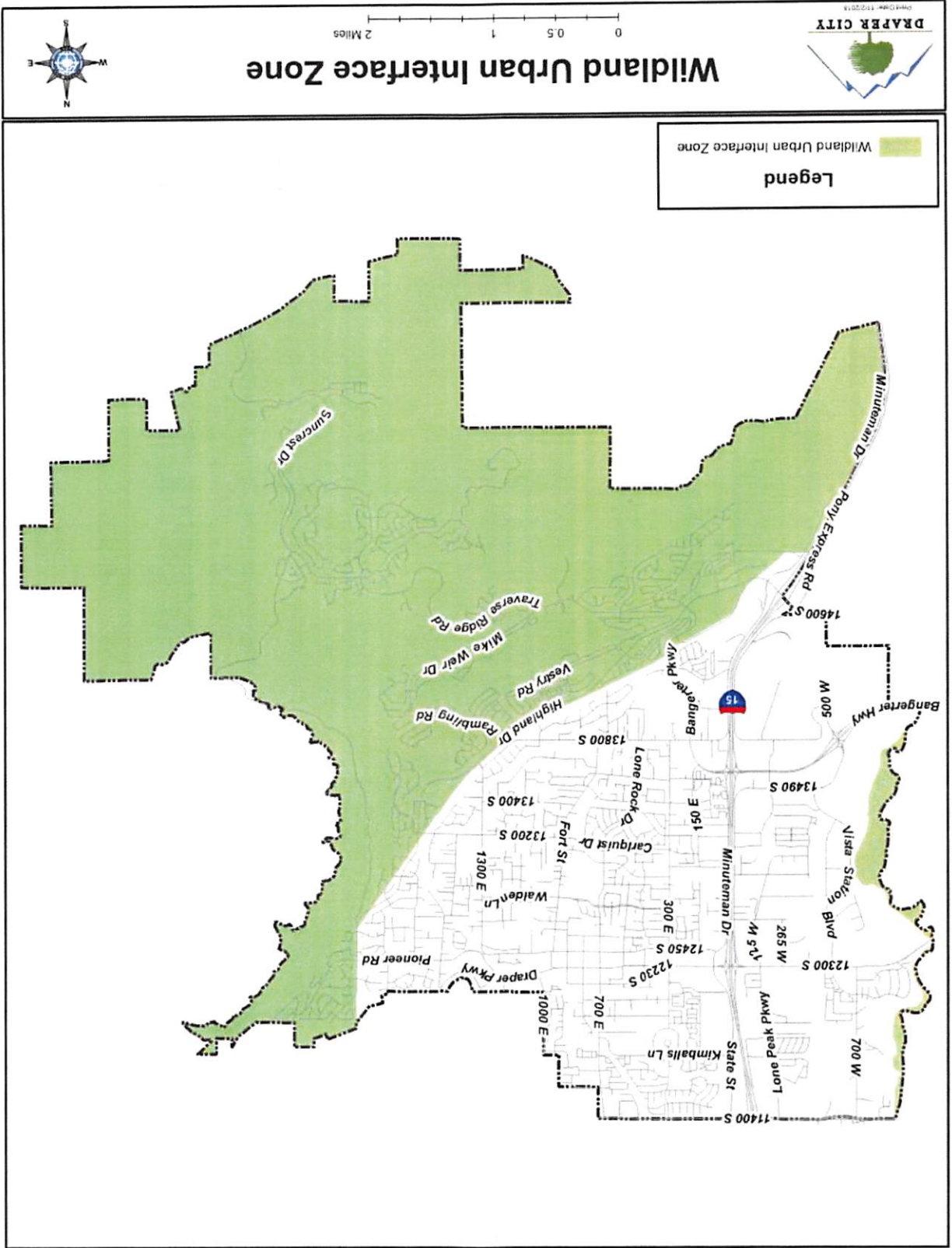
**EXHIBIT A**

**COMPLETE PROPOSED TEXT AMENDMENT**

**7-10-020: FIRE CODE:**

A) The most recent version of the International Fire Code published by the International Conference of Building Officials and adopted by the State of Utah, including all appendices thereto, is hereby adopted as the Fire Code of Draper City. (Ord. 185, 8-8-1995)

B) The most recent version of the Utah Wildland Urban Interface Code, issued by the International Code Council and adopted by the State of Utah, with the alternatives or amendment approved by the Utah Division of Forestry, is hereby adopted as the Wildland Urban Interface Code of Draper City.
