

ORDINANCE NO. 1364

AN ORDINANCE OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL AMENDING SECTION 3-1-230 OF THE DRAPER CITY MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE TREE COMMISSION QUORUM

WHEREAS on February 16, 1999, Draper City established the Draper Tree Commission whose purpose to act as an advisory board to the City Council and other City departments on matters relating to tree culture including the establishment, maintenance and upkeep of all trees, shrubs and other plant life located on City property; and

WHEREAS the current membership language in Section 3-1-230 allows up to 11 members; and

WHEREAS from time to time, the Tree Commission does not have enough members attend to have a quorum and cannot hold their regularly scheduled meeting; and

WHEREAS the City Council desires to amend the code to define the minimum number of members to establish a quorum.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3-1-230 of the Draper City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, part, or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance, and all sections, parts, and provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication or posting, or 30 days after final passage, whichever is closer to the date of final passage.



EXHIBIT A

Section 3-1-230 Draper City Tree Commission

(c) Organization and Procedure.

(1) Chairperson. The Mayor shall appoint a member of the Commission to serve as Chair to oversee the proceedings and activities of the Commission. The Commission may elect other officers as it deems necessary.

(2) Rules. The Commission may propose reasonable bylaws, rules and regulations in accordance with this section to regulate the conduct of its meetings in accordance with established City Policies and Procedures, which bylaws, rules and regulations must be approved and adopted by resolution of the City Council before becoming effective.

(3) Meetings. The Commission may hold meetings at such times as the Commission determines are necessary and as properly called with notices duly provided to each Commission member and as required by law. Three members of the Commission shall constitute a quorum. The minimum number of yes votes required for the Commission to take any action shall be three.
