Lone Peak parkway:

- Project starts in May and aiming for ending in August
- Draper city is offering “cost to care” because the park strip is private. So, the city will pay them to replace the trees and they will still do the maintenance; the city can make recommendations on trees. Otherwise, the city will plant the recommended trees if they don’t opt for cost to cure. The sidewalks will be straightened out and there will be some trees taken out.

### Peak View Trail-head Plan Review

- Civic Solutions did the landscaping plan. Planned trees were Bigtooth Maples, Hackberry, and gamble oak
- Elevation is estimated at about 6000 ft.
- Recommended trees are:
  - Remove big tooth maples and replace with Acer tarterica (not as finicky)
  - Gamble oak is fine, but don’t use B&B and use container instead
  - Hackberry - use Burr oak instead
  - Hancock coralberry won’t do well at that altitude
  - Rhett will send the plan to Janet and she will respond with alternate recommendations
- Beacon crest on Pioneer Road trees assisted living center behind the credit union
  - Action: MaryAnn will follow up on the tree species
- Harmony Hills - no park strip and thus no trees
- Multi-family - Zelkovas and we are okay with that plan

### Jordan Valley Water conservancy district recommendations

- Any new development in their district must adopt their standards
- Russ explained the Draper city staff has done a review
  - Issue is that it goes into a residential review - potential issues with residents who want more sod

- Other requirements aren't feasible - such as city having an architect for residential review of irrigation
- We can use this as a guideline as we revise our landscaping codes
  - Actions:
    - Tree commission to review the JV recommendations and comment
    - Review the codes with this as a reference
  - Current commercial codes are options - we can let this influence that
