

ORDINANCE NO. 1453

AN ORDINANCE OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL ENACTING SECTION 3-1-320 OF THE DRAPER CITY MUNICIPAL CODE CREATING THE DRAPER CITY DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, Title 3 of the Draper City Municipal Code (“Title 3”) regulates general provisions regarding boards, commissions, and committees; and

WHEREAS, the City is seeking input regarding diversity, equality and inclusivity within the City, therefore, it is necessary for the city to create the Draper City Diversity and Inclusion Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the proposed text and finds good cause to amend Title 3 to create the Draper City Diversity and Inclusion Advisory Board.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings. The City Council of Draper City has made the following findings to amend Title 3 of the Draper City Municipal Code: 1) the City is seeking input for initiatives that cultivate an inclusive culture and stimulate socio-economic equality for the greater community. 2) The City is seeking input regarding diversity, equality and inclusivity within the City. 3) The proposed amendments are in compliance with the Utah Code Annotated. 4) The proposed amendments are in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Draper.

Section 2. Enactment. Section 3-1-320 of the Draper City Municipal Code is hereby enacted to read as shown in Exhibit “A” attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. Correction of Editing Errors. The City Attorney is authorized to make non-substantive corrections to the attached Exhibit A, which may include corrections of punctuation, spelling, formatting, or similar errors prior to submitting the Ordinance to American Legal Publishing.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, part, or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance, and all sections, parts, and provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication or posting, or 30 days after final passage, whichever is closer to the date of final passage.

EXHIBIT A
COMPLETE PROPOSED TEXT AMENDMENT

3-1-320 DRAPER CITY DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION ADVISORY BOARD:

A. Creation: There is hereby created the Draper City Diversity and Inclusion Advisory Board to act as an advisory board on identifying issues faced by diverse groups and creating opportunities for an inclusive community within the City.

B. Members:

1. Number: The Advisory Board shall be comprised of up to nine (9) but not less than five (5) members who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the City Council.

2. Term: Members shall be appointed to terms of two (2) years. In order to provide for proper staggering of terms so that all appointments do not expire at the same time and to provide appropriate opportunities for involvement by a variety of interested persons, two (2) initial membership positions shall be for a term of one (1) year, three initial membership position shall be for a term of two (2) years.

C. Organization and Procedure:

1. Chair: The Mayor shall appoint one of the members to serve as Chair of the Advisory Board for a term of two (2) years. The Chair shall oversee the proceedings and activities of the board.

2. Rules: The Advisory Board may adopt reasonable rules in accordance with this chapter to govern the conduct of its business.

3. Meetings: The Advisory Board shall hold meetings quarterly or as the Chair deems necessary as properly called with notice given to each board member. Meetings shall comply with the Utah Open and Public Meetings Act.

D. Duties:

It shall be the duty of the Advisory Board to act in a voluntary and advisory capacity to the City regarding diversity, equality and inclusivity activities within the City, including, but not limited to:

1. Act as a liaison to inform the City of issues faced by diverse communities and groups.
2. Advocate and voice support for initiatives that cultivate an inclusive culture and stimulate socio-economic equality for the greater community.
3. Create educational opportunities through guest lectures at local schools and community workshops to raise awareness of diversity, equality and inclusivity issues.
4. Host events for the greater community to celebrate and educate the public about various cultures and diverse groups; and
5. Assist with developing resource materials related to topics of diversity, equality, and inclusivity for the City.
