ORDINANCE NO. 1489

AN ORDINANCE OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL AMENDING TITLE 2 OF THE DRAPER CITY MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING PUBLICATION OF APPROVED ORDINANCES AND ELECTION NOTICES.

WHEREAS, Title 2 of the Draper City Municipal Code ("DCMC") includes provisions regarding the publication of ordinances and election notices; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary from time to time to revise certain terms of the DCMC to address changes in state law applicable to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the proposed text amendment and finds good cause to revise the terms and provisions of Title 2.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Findings. The City Council of Draper City has made the following findings to amend Title 2 of the Draper City Municipal Code: 1) Certain provisions of Title 2 have been impacted by changes in state law; 2) the proposed amendments to Title 2 are in compliance with the Utah Code Annotated; and 3) the proposed amendments are in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Draper.

<u>Section 2. Revision.</u> Title 2 of the DCMC is hereby amended to read as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 3. Correction of Editing Errors.</u> The City Attorney is authorized to make non-substantive corrections to the attached Exhibit A, which may include corrections of punctuation, spelling, formatting, or similar errors prior to submitting the Ordinance to Sterling Codifiers.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability</u>. If any section, part, or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance, and all sections, parts, and provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable.

<u>Section 5</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication or posting, or 30 days after final passage, whichever is closer to the date of final passage.

Chapter 2-4 LEGISLATION

Section 2-4-010 Ordinances.

- H. Publication.
- 1. All ordinances, except those enacted pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 10-3-706 through 10-3-710, as amended, shall be deposited in the office of the City Recorder and a short summary of the ordinance shall be <u>posted on the Utah Public Notice Website</u>; published at least once in a newspaper published within Draper City, or if there is no newspaper published in Draper City, in a newspaper of general circulation within the city; or a complete copy of the ordinance shall be posted in three public places within Draper City, before taking effect.

Section 2-6-020 Election of Mayor and Council Members

A. Elected. The mayor and council members shall be elected in an at-large municipal election held on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November, of each odd-numbered year as provided in Utah Code Annotated title 10, chapter 3.

- B. Notice of Election. On or before May 1 in a year in which there is a municipal general election, the city recorder shall publish a notice that identifies the municipal offices to be voted on in the municipal election and the dates for filing a declaration of candidacy. The city recorder shall publish the notice on the Utah Public Notice Website and in at least one of the following ways:
 - 1. at city hall;
 - 2. in a newspaper of general circulation in the city at least once a week for two consecutive weeks in accordance with Utah Code Annotated section 45-1-101, et seq.;
 - 3. 2 in the city newsletter;
 - 4. 3 on the city's website; or
 - 5. 4 with a city utility enterprise fund customer's bill.
