Dear Draper Business Owners,

As our community continues to adapt to the ever-changing economic realities of living through the COVID-19 pandemic, we want you to know that we are trying to lower barriers to doing business in Draper City.

Every dime saved is another dime that you pump directly back into our economy and, to that end, **Draper City is waiving all business license renewal penalty fees (late fees) for business licenses that are currently expired.** This penalty waiver shall be retroactive to February 1, 2020 and be in effect until June 30, 2021. Essentially, if your business license has expired you will not be charged penalty fees to bring your business license current. If you are a business that has paid penalty fees during this timeframe, email businesslicensing@draper.ut.us to request a refund. You will however be responsible for the business license application fees as outlined in the City's consolidated fee schedule.

Additionally the Draper City Council authorized **free temporary sign permits** for banner signs to assist businesses in advertising that they are open! If you haven't applied for a temporary sign permit please contact us at planning@draper.ut.us to start your application now.

Finally, on November 17, 2020, the Draper City Council adopted an ordinance **allowing temporary, tented outdoor restaurant seating** to help accommodate restaurant social distancing requirements throughout the winter months!
