Commercial Business License Application

Draper City Business Licensing

Overview



A business license is the means whereby Draper City grants a business permission to engage in the activities the license is issued for. If a business is licensed it means that the business is properly zoned for the activity being conducted and meets all state and local code requirements. If you engage in any business — either permanently or temporarily — within Draper City, you are required to maintain a valid, unexpired business license. However, only commercial businesses with a fixed physical presence within Draper are required to obtain a business license. Furthermore, food trucks with a valid business license issued by a government entity do not need to apply for a Draper City business license.

Application Process

- 1. Register your business with the Division of Corporations and Commercial Code (this is not required for sole proprietorships).
- 2. Register your business with the Internal Revenue Service and obtain an Employer Identification Number (EIN). EINs are issued for the purpose of tax administration (note that EINs are not required for sole proprietorships).
- 3. Submit the Commercial Business License Application to the Business License Official. Once processed, the applicant will receive an email requesting missing documentation (if any). When all documents are received, an invoice to pay for the business license is sent to the applicant via email.
- 4. Your business will be remotely or physically inspected by the Draper Fire, Building, Planning, and GIS divisions to ensure compliance with addressing, zoning, code, and safety regulations. Once approval is granted and the license is paid for it will be issued to the applicant via email.

Required Documents

Various documents are required in order to obtain a Commercial Business License. What documents are needed depends on what kind of services the business renders.

- <u>Proof of Business Registration:</u> Must provide proof that the business is registered with the Utah Division of Corporations and Commercial Code. This includes copies of the articles of organization, certificates of registration, or other official paperwork. Sole proprietors may show DBA registration, if available.
- <u>Utah Sales Tax License:</u> Required if selling or leasing tangible goods or transferring products electronically. The sales tax license must list Draper as the city in which the business is registered to make taxable sales.
- <u>Professional License</u>: Required if the business being conducted is licensed by the Utah Department of Professional Licensing or another state agency.
- Health and Human Services Permit: Required if regulated by the Utah Department of Health and Human Services.
- <u>Health Permit:</u> Required if regulated by the Salt Lake County Health Department or the Utah Department of Agriculture and Food.
- <u>Criminal Background Check:</u> Required for certain business operations identified in Draper City
 Resolution No. 05-17. Background checks are performed by the Utah Bureau of Criminal Identification
 or the Draper City Police Department and must be made within the last year of application. A
 background check from another state or federal agency may also be accepted.
