



2025 DRAPER DAYS PARADE LINE UP

Thank you for being part of the 2025 Draper Days Parade! This community tradition is a non-political, family-oriented parade that seeks to honor the pioneer history and sense of community of Draper City.

Inside this guide, you'll find your entry number, staging area, and key safety information to help ensure a smooth and enjoyable experience.



✓ STAGING & CHECK-IN

- Find your **Entry Number** (your group's position in the parade) and your **Staging Area** (the area where you wait to start the parade) in this document.
- Ensure that every member of your group knows their entry name, entry number, and staging area.
- There are two staging areas where entries wait before the parade begins. Find them on the Parade Map in this document. Each staging area has a specific access point.
- Staging Area Access Points:
 - Staging Area 1 (Stokes):** Enter from 300 East (**there is no other access point**)
 - Staging Area 2 (Fort Street):** Enter from 13800 South (**there is no other access point**)
- Staging Areas open at 6:30 am; entries must be in their designated Staging Area by 8:00 am, and the parade starts promptly at 9:00 am.
- Only vehicles that are in the parade are allowed into the Staging Areas.
- Upon arrival, please check in with Parade Staff. Staff will confirm your entry details, inspect your entry for safety, collect all Participant Release and Waiver Forms, and answer any final questions.
- If your entry is deemed unsafe, of low quality, or does not match the approved application, Parade Staff reserves the right to disqualify your group from participating.

✓ LOGISTICS

- **Water:** Bring plenty of water for your group to stay hydrated.
- **Arrive Early:** Expect heavy traffic around the Staging Areas and arrive early to avoid delays.
- **Drop-Offs:** Only parade vehicles are allowed in staging areas. Walking participants must be dropped off nearby and walk to their assigned location.
- **Restrooms:** Restrooms are located at each staging area and at the Parade Grandstand.

✓ CAMPAINGING & POLITICAL ISSUES

- Parade Entries that advocate for or against the election or reelection of a particular candidate, or for or against a political issue or ballot proposition, are prohibited

✓ SAFETY

- **No Getting On or Off Vehicles:** No one may mount or dismount a vehicle, float, or trailer at any time during the parade, whether it is in motion or stationary. ***This is one of the most dangerous behaviors we see and is strictly prohibited.***
- **Item Throwing Requires Spotters:** If your entry tosses or distributes items (e.g., candy), you are required to provide four adult spotters, two on each side of the vehicle. These spotters must walk the whole route to keep spectators at a safe distance. ***This rule exists to prevent serious injury or death.***
- **Minimum Age Requirement:** All participants who are marching or walking in the parade must be at least 13 years old —***no exceptions.***
- **Vehicle Speed Limit:** The maximum speed for all vehicles is 2.5 mph (approximately walking pace). This ensures pedestrian safety and prevents collisions from occurring.
- **Driver Requirements:** All drivers must be at least 18 years old, hold a valid driver's license, carry vehicle insurance, and wear seat belt restraints at all times.
- **Release & Waivers Required:** Every participant must complete and sign the Release and Waiver form. Release and Waivers forms may be returned before the parade by email or handed in during check-in.

Parade Route & Staging Areas

- The Draper Days Parade takes place on Fort St between Stokes Ave and Pioneer Rd. It is 1.5 miles in length and is limited to 100 entries.
- Parade entries are to be in their assigned staging line-up location no less than one hour prior to the parade start time for inspection and final approval for participation by City Staff. If staff deems an entry unsafe, poor in quality or different than what was approved through the application process, the entry will be disqualified and not allowed to participate in the parade.
- Staging Information Booth located at the LDS building at 420 E Stokes Ave (13540 S).
- Participants marching or walking in the parade must be 13 years of age or older.
- Participants are prohibited from getting onto or off of any parade vehicle, float, or trailer, moving or stopped, during the course of the parade.
- All parade participants (whether riding on a float or trailer or walking) or their legal guardians are required to sign a waiver and release before participating.
