SWPPP Template – Common Plan Permit

A Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) is a site-specific document that identifies potential sources of storm water pollution, describes practices to reduce pollutants in storm water discharges, and identifies procedures the operator will implement to comply with the terms and conditions of the construction storm water permit.

The Utah Division of Water Quality (DWQ) provides a SWPPP template designed to help operators and/or their designees prepare a SWPPP that meets the requirements of the Common Plan Permit.

How to Access the DWQ SWPPP template

1. Visit the Utah Department of Environmental Quality website:

2. Scroll to the navy-colored “Common Plan Permit” tab located mid-page and select it.
3. Click “Resources”.
